

## LAST BUSES BACK TO ALBUFEIRA

THESE ARE THE LAST BUSES OR TRAINS BACK TO ALBUFEIRA  
FROM THE PLACES YOU ARE MOST LIKELY TO VISIT.

Sunday bus times apply on [Public Holidays](#). These are direct buses unless stated otherwise

**The buses in red stop only in Albufeira's bus station, which is 1.6km / 1 mile from the town centre**

Where trains are mentioned remember that Albufeira's station is nearly 4 miles / 6km from town

**Summer times now in effect and shown here. These apply until 30<sup>th</sup> October subject to change of course!**
